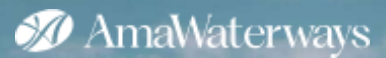

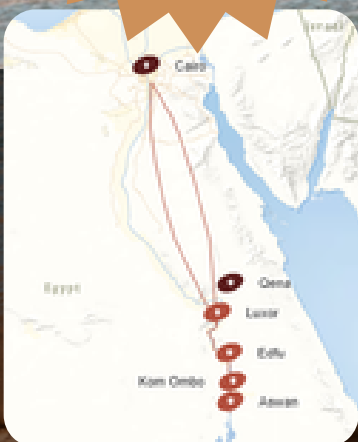

DAY 1 • CAIRO

Arrive in Cairo and meet your AmaWaterways representative, who will assist with luggage and customs before transferring you to your hotel.

DAY 2 • CAIRO

Visit the spectacular new Grand Egyptian Museum, home to 100,000 artifacts, including the treasures of Tutankhamun. Enjoy lunch before visiting the Alabaster Mosque atop the Citadel of Saladin, with sweeping views across Cairo toward the Pyramids. In the evening, enjoy a Welcome Reception with your Cruise Manager. (B, L, WR)



DAY 3 • CAIRO

Explore ancient Memphis and its monuments, including the massive statue of Ramses II, the Alabaster Sphinx and the Step Pyramid of Sakkara. Enjoy lunch at the historic Mena House, then discover the Great Sphinx and iconic Pyramids of Giza. Evening at leisure. (B, L)

DAY 4 • CAIRO • LUXOR • EMBARKATION

Visit historic Coptic Cairo before flying south to Luxor, the former capital of Upper Egypt. Explore this UNESCO World Heritage Site, home to the magnificent Karnak and Luxor Temples, before boarding your luxurious Nile River cruise. Celebrate with a Captain's Welcome Cocktail. (B, L, D)



DAY 5 • LUXOR

Discover the Valley of Queens and the legendary Valley of the Kings, including King Tutankhamun's tomb and Seti I's Tomb. Visit the Temple of Hatshepsut and the towering Colossi of Memnon before returning to the ship. Relax on deck or join an informal cooking class. (B, L, D) Note: Queen Nefertari's Tomb is currently closed. Seti I's Tomb will be visited as an alternative until reopening.



DAY 6 • EDFU

Visit the remarkably preserved Temple of Horus, one of Egypt's most impressive ancient temples and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Then relax aboard your ship as you cruise along the timeless Nile toward Aswan. (B, L, D)

DAY 7 • ASWAN

Enjoy a morning at leisure or take an optional excursion to Abu Simbel, featuring its awe-inspiring UNESCO-designated temples. Later, enjoy a peaceful felucca ride around Elephantine Island. Optional afternoon tea at the historic Old Cataract Hotel is also available. (B, L, D)



DAY 8 • ASWAN • KOM OMBO

Explore the stunning Philae Temple complex by motorboat before visiting a colorful Nubian village and meeting its welcoming residents. Cruise onward to Kom Ombo and visit its unique temple dedicated to the gods Sobek and Haroeris. In the evening, celebrate local culture with traditional Galabeya attire and festivities. (B, L, D)



DAY 9 • LUXOR

Enjoy a scenic morning cruise along the Nile before exploring the magnificent Temple of Karnak, one of the largest religious complexes in the world. Visit a papyrus museum to learn about this ancient Egyptian art, then discover the impressive Temple of Luxor. Return to the ship to relax or explore the colorful Luxor Market. (B, L, D)



DAY 10 • LUXOR • QENA
Cruise to Qena and visit Dendara, home to the remarkably preserved Temple of Hathor, Goddess of Love. See the famous relief of Cleopatra and her son Caesarion before sailing back to Luxor. (B, L, D)

DAY 11 • LUXOR • CAIRO • DISEMBARKATION

Disembark in Luxor and fly to Cairo. Visit the magnificent Abdeen Presidential Palace and its fascinating museums before enjoying a special lunch at the palace. (B, L)

DAY 12 • CAIRO

Bid farewell to Cairo and prepare for your flight home. (B)
