DAY 1: ARRIVE IN DUBROVNIK

Arrive in Dubrovnik. Transfer to your hotel. Get a good night's rest and look forward to the adventure ahead.

DAY 2: DUBROVNIK

Transfer from the Dubrovnik hotel to Gruz Harbor, where embarkation begins at 2:00pm. Meet your fellow travelers and your Cruise Manager later at an on-board Welcome Reception. This evening, you can relax or take a walk through Dubrovnik's vibrant streets. (B,D)

DAY 3: DUBROVNIK - ŠIPAN ISLAND / SLANO

After breakfast, explore the stunning UNESCO-listed city of Dubrovnik with a guided tour, then wander on your own—stroll the City Walls or take the cable car for breathtaking views from Mount Srd. In the afternoon, we'll cruise to the charming, picturesque village of Šipanska Luka, a peaceful Adriatic retreat. Enjoy dinner on board and relax overnight in this serene island setting. (B,D)

DAY 4: ŠIPAN ISLAND - NATIONAL PARK

MLJET - KORČULA

Start your day with a scenic cruise to Mljet National Park, where you can explore the Great and Small Lakes, visit the 12th-century

Benedictine Monastery on St. Mary's Islet, and take a refreshing swim in this natural paradise. After lunch on board, continue cruising to Korčula Island, the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo, and enjoy a guided tour through the town's charming, narrow streets. The evening is yours to relax and savor dinner at one of Korčula's local restaurants. (B,L)



DAY 5: KORČULA - VIS

Morning cruise to Vis Island where we expect to come after lunch with swim stop. Vis is a pearl among Croatian Adriatic islands, left untouched by the development of tourism for so many years - due to its strategic location on the open sea, it served as a military zone for many years. Beautiful beaches, and preserved nature, ecological agriculture and preserved traditional architecture are unique advantages of this unique Croatian island where we will spend afternoon in Vis town on Vis Island. DAY 6: VIS - BIŠEVO BLUE CAVE - HVAR

Cruise to the enchanting Island of Biševo and marvel at the magical Blue Cave, where sunlight transforms the waters into dazzling shades of deep blue and silver. After a swim and lunch on board, continue to Hvar, Croatia's sunniest island, famous for its stunning coves, vibrant culture, and historic lavender traditions. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided walk through Hvar town before an evening at leisure to explore and dine in its charming local restaurants. (B, L)



DAY 7: HVAR - BOL - TROGIR

Begin your day with a cruise to Bol, home to Croatia's famous Zlatni Rat (Golden Cape) beach, where you can stroll the charming town, enjoy a coffee, or take a refreshing swim. After lunch on board, continue to the historic town of Trogir, a UNESCO World Heritage site filled with stone houses, palaces, churches, and towers. Explore Trogir with an English-speaking guide, including the stunning Cathedral of St. Lawrence, a masterpiece of Croatian sacral architecture. (B, L)



DAY 8: TROGIR - SPLIT

Enjoy a morning cruise to Split, with a swim stop along the way, followed by lunch on board. Explore the historic Diocletian's Palace with an English-speaking guide and discover the rich history of this UNESCO World Heritage city, over 1,700 years old. After the tour, enjoy free time to wander Split's charming streets and savor a farewell dinner at one of the city's local restaurants, with an overnight docking in Split's historic town. (B, L)



DAY 9: SPLIT

After breakfast, it's time to say farewell to your new friends and the unforgettable memories made on this Adriatic adventure.
